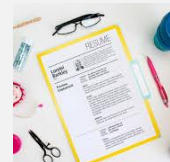
Favourite place?

A pair of vintage Louis Vuitton brogues in mint green – these are very old and quite unique. It takes a very special occasion to bring these out.



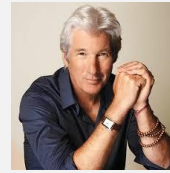
Favourite thing about your job?
